to Christ our God.

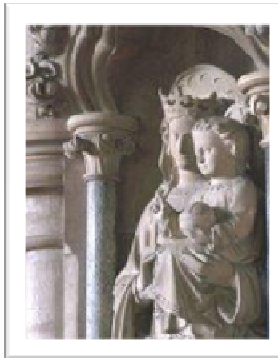
To you Lord, as is fitting,
